2. Title of the practice: - Protection of Environment

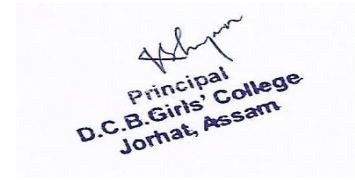
Objectives of the practice: - To create awareness on the importance of environment protection.

- D.C.B. Girls' College Students' Union and Alumni Association organized Environmental Awareness Meeting on 07-06-2022.


- A poster competition was organized by department of Geography on the occasion of World Food Day on 15-10-2022.
