

## Feedback analysis 2021-2022

With quality sustenance as its focus, the IQAC of the university has developed the feedback mechanism commencing with obtaining feedback from the different stakeholders such as students, alumni, teachers, parents and employers in formal as well as sometimes informal ways.

- Feedback from Students-Google form was created and sent to students. As many as 184 responses have been received on syllabus, teaching learning process and institutional facility and 83.6% response on ambition after graduation and 124 responses on sessional examination evaluation process. In the student feedback, it includes parameters on teaching, syllabus, future planning, library facility etc.
- Teachers feedback is shared by individually or by the head of the departments of the college and the collected forms were forwarded to the authorities for further action.
- Alumni feedback is collected during alumni meeting & even online. The filled in forms were sent for further action. Employer feedback is collected in a different ways as it is a challenge to keep a track of the students working in different fields and their employers. However some departments of the college communicate the working students by the means of e-mail or telephone and online social media.
- For Parents feedback each of the department of the college arrange guardian meeting.

Methodology-The data get is compiled and analyzed by members of the committee. It then goes for deliberation to the IQAC. The feedback committee collects inputs and suggestions from stakeholders and further action were taken on discussion with departments and authorities. The decision taken by the authorities are forwarded for action to be initiated.

### Feedback analysis:

1. The syllabus of your course-

96.1% of the students have agreed that syllabus is creating interest in them with good satisfactory response. The syllabus of the college provides different cross-cutting issues on human value, environment, sustainable development, gender issues, professional ethics etc.

2. How much of your syllabus was taught in the class?

97.8 % of the students confirm that the syllabus has been completed nearly 70%. The 2% responses of the students who confirm the syllabus covered less than 50% was because of other responsibilities and program which was notified about this to the HoDs.

3. Are you satisfied with the academic Activities of the Department?

83.7% of the students were fully satisfied with the academic activities of the Departments as they are encouraged to take part in various activities (seminar, debate, painting, creative writing, quiz, internship, field study, project etc.) apart from the curriculum. On this 13.6.5% and nearly 3%

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who were partially satisfied and not satisfied respectively to makeup the HoDs are being advised to encourage students for more such activities to the less effort students.

4. What is your ambition after graduation?

Most of the students of the college are ambitious. It was found after graduation 83.6% will pursue higher education in various institutions and Universities. To push them up the career counseling cell arrange some of the programs. 14.1% will look out for jobs as they were initiated through the different career related programs in the college. Along with it the other student were looking for entrepreneurship and business.

5. Are you satisfied with the present examination and evaluation system?

73.6 % and 19.8% of the students were satisfied and partially satisfied respectively by the examination conducted according to academic calendar and evaluation system as the college makes certain of transparency in evaluation. The college displays the students' performance in the notice board. And only 6.6% not satisfied were notified to all HoDs to evaluate the students more appropriately.

6. How far do you find the administrative office of the Institution helpful?

81.2% of the students find the administrative office of the institution helpful. The office staffs of the administration help students in the admissions process, registration, examination, certificate issues during the working hours. But due to extensive work there used be space in their work and help.

7. Do you find the library beneficial for the course?


78.5 % of the students find the library beneficial for their course and out of it 53.8% find library adequate with good number of books, journals, magazine and newspaper along with access to some open source notes and books. For the rest who were expecting better service were notified to the Librarian of the college for further expansion in study material and resources.

8. Institutional facilities.

More than 50% of the students take the college facilities- computer/internet, hostel, canteen, common room, counseling, electricity and recreational facility very good and good but the authority has taken initiative to increase and enhanced the facility for the students.

9. What is your opinion regarding Sessional examination and Internal evaluation?

More than 50% of the student find sessional examinations very helpful as it guide them for final examination preparation. The students are also satisfied with the internal evaluation process and maintaining the transparency of assessment on each of attendance, group discussion and assignment.


  
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10. How do you rate the Student Teacher Relationship in the Department of the College?

46.8.2% and 41% rate the teacher's student relationship in the department as very good and good respectively. The teachers of the college are supportive, provide choice in learning and encouraged students to become strong learner. Although, the authority advice the faculties to communicate more with the students with different activities of their interest.

11. Overall Rating

77.9 % of the students feel the overall effectiveness of the institution and rated good to very good. There is scope for further improvement and hence it is recommended to the teachers to enhance the overall criteria of the college.

  
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
