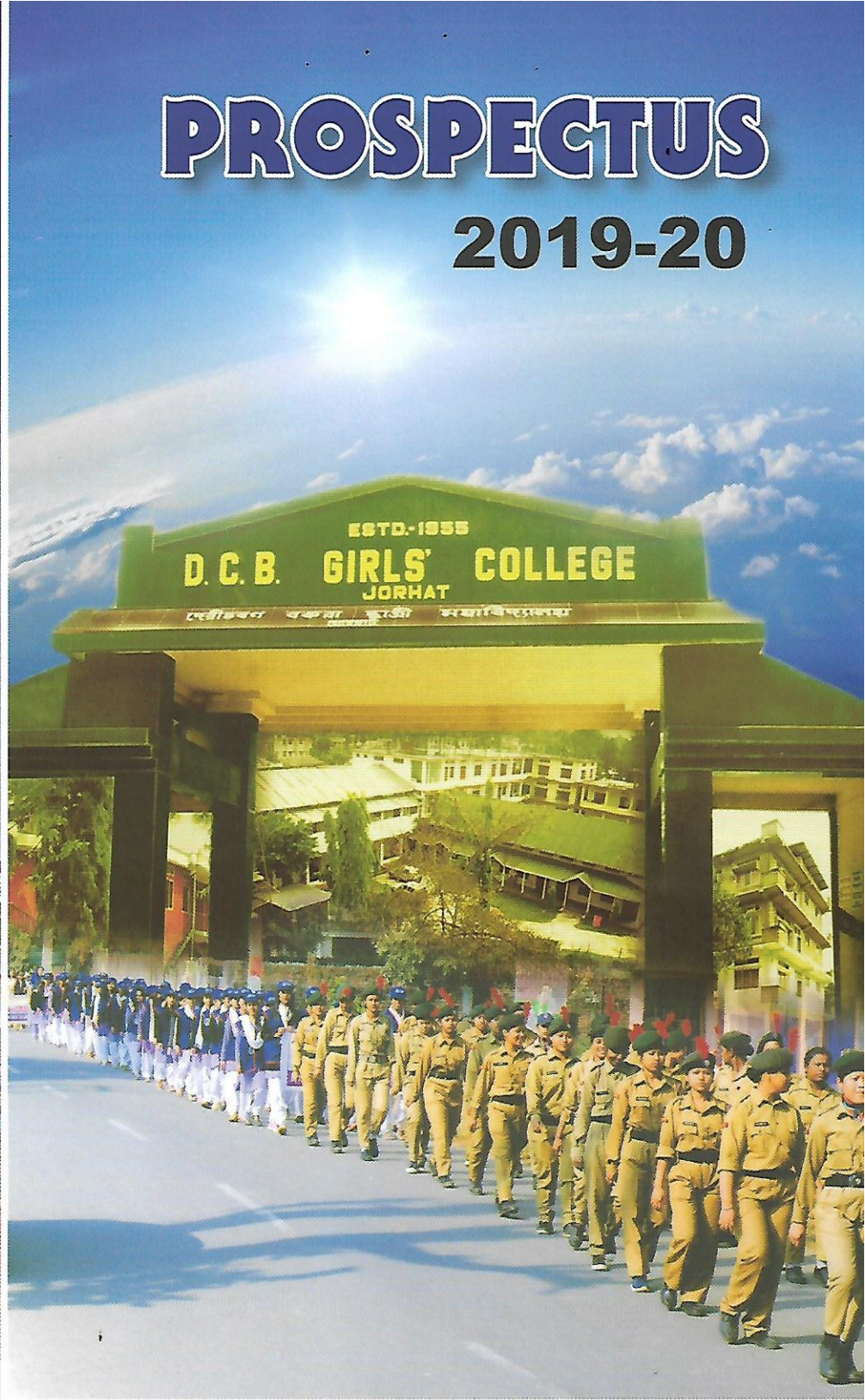
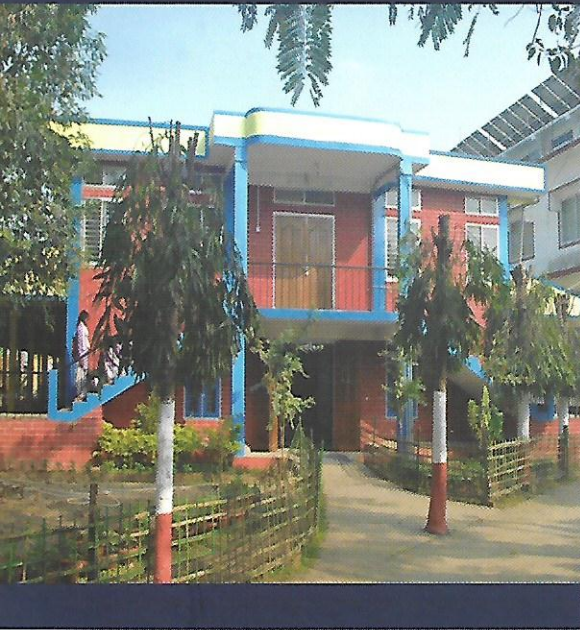

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INTRODUCTION

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Devi Charan Barua Girls' College is the first under-graduate girls' college in Upper Assam and second oldest among the women colleges of the state. Since its inception in the year 1955, it has been striving incessantly to spread women education in Assam. The college was established with generous contributions made by the four illustrious sons of Late Rai Bahadur Devi Charan Barua, viz., Heramba Prasad Barua, Umacharan Barua, Deba Prasad Barua and Bishnu Charan Barua. Starting with a modest enrolment of only 56 students and 12 teachers in the Arts Stream, the college has now grown from strength to strength and accommodates approximately 1800 students from diverse backgrounds, communities and states of North East India in Arts and Science faculty.

Over the years, the college has produced women who have excelled in diverse professions and have contributed in numerous ways to the society at large.

During the 62 years of its glorious existence, the college has not only distinguished itself as one of the premier Degree Colleges of the State but also of the NE Region of India. In fact, D C B Girls' College is the first girls' college of the state to be awarded Grade "A" by NAAC.

The Science Stream was added to its wings in 1981 and since then it has developed itself into a full fledged one with well equipped laboratories. The 10+2 programme offered by the college is affiliated to the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC), while its Degree programme is affiliated to the Dibrugarh University (DU).

In the academic sphere, the college has always maintained standards of the highest order. Since 2016-17, the college has been imparting M.A. Degree in Assamese, Education and Political Science under KKHSOU. Under NIOS the college has started D.EL.Ed classes from 2018. It has also introduced PGDCA course from 2017-18. Besides striving for academic excellence, the college firmly believes in the holistic development of its students. It assigns equal importance to co-curricular activities, including games and sports. The "Cultural Team" of the College, in particular, has always been a force to reckon with in the annual Inter-College Youth Festival of Dibrugarh University. D C B Girls' College is also well known for its NCC/ NSS/Extension/ Counselling and Placement wings. Its NCC cadets have brought laurels to the college as well as the state by their excellent performances in events like mountaineering, shooting and other adventure sports, including participation in the prestigious Republic Day parade at New Delhi.

The real strength of the college lies in its highly qualified teachers and resourceful administrative staff. The faculty is renowned for their meritorious profile, versatile talent and dedication to the cause of women education.

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ADMISSION

Regular students will be preferred for admission to the Higher Secondary and Degree Programmes. However, students passing the qualifying examination earlier year will have to submit a gap certificate from competent authority. Candidates having more than three years of study gap are not considered for admission. Students seeking admission in the reserved category must produce caste certificate in original at the time of admission. The College authority will have the final discretion for admission into the Higher Secondary and Degree Major Programs.

ELIGIBILITY

Admission will be strictly on the basis of merit. However State Government reservation norms shall be followed for admission into reserved categories.

Students passing out H.S. Examination from this college does not possess any special claim for automatic admission in the Degree Course.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application forms along with prospectus for different programmes of study can be obtained on payment of Rs.150/- (for new students) and Rs.50/- (for existing students) by Cash or Demand Draft or by Cross Indian Postal Order drawn in favour of "The Principal, DCB Girls' College, Jorhat." Alternately, candidates can download the prospectus from our website, www.dcbgirlscollegejorhat.org. They can also apply 'online' for admission in the website and submit the printed form. But they have to pay an amount of Rs.150/- at the time of admission.

Candidates possessing requisite qualifications are eligible to apply for different courses offered by the College.

NOTE ▶ Applicants must go through the Prospectus carefully before filling up the Application Form.

FEE & MODE OF PAYMENT

Payment of fees shall be as per government guidelines. Fees are to be deposited in the office counter in cash/pos during office hours or through electronic mode.

GENERAL RULES OF ADMISSION

- ❑ Applications for admission must be submitted in the prescribed form in the College Office within the stipulated dates.
- ❑ For admission into the Higher Secondary 1st Year Class, a student must have passed the High School Leaving Certificate Examination conducted by SEBA or any other equivalent examination.
- ❑ For admission into the B.A./B.Sc. 1st Semester Class, a student must have passed the Higher Secondary Examination conducted by A.H.S.E.C. or any other equivalent examination.
- ❑ Admission is purely on merit basis. Students with outstanding Sports/Cultural background (represented at District level and above) are given preference subject to submission of relevant certificates from competent authority.
- ❑ Reservation of seats as per norms of Assam Govt. will be extended to ST/SC/OBC/MOBC/PH students subject to submission of relevant certificates from competent authority. In case any seat in the reserved category remains vacant, the same will be filled from the unreserved category.
- ❑ Date(s) for interview/admission will be notified on the college notice board and local newspapers. Students selected for admission are required to produce the following documents in original at the time of admission:
 - a) Mark Sheet and Certificate of the last examination passed.
 - b) Age Proof Certificate.
 - c) Caste Certificate wherever necessary.
 - d) A Certificate of good conduct from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- ❑ A student who does not attend classes for **seven days continuously** from the date of commencement of regular classes, without any information, her admission will automatically stand cancelled.
- ❑ Students, other than 1st Semester, must take admission on the specified dates as notified by the College Authority, failing which a late fine of Rs. 200/- will be imposed.
- ❑ College authority will not be responsible for any wrong statement of facts whatsoever given by the students in their Admission Forms.
- ❑ All admissions are provisional and subject to verification of the relevant documents and fulfilment of necessary conditions of the College.
- ❑ Admission into the College is governed by the College admission rules. The Principal's decision regarding admission is final and binding.
- ❑ Any pressure or interference from any quarter for the admission of a particular student will result in forfeiture of the claim.

RULES FOR OFFERING CORE (MAJOR) PROGRAMMES

1. Change of subject(s) including Core subject is not allowed.
2. Candidates who passed Higher Secondary Examination in the Science Stream can take admission in the B.A. Programme.
3. Candidates willing to offer Core in Physics must have passed in Mathematics at the Higher Secondary level.
4. Candidates willing to offer Core in English and Assamese must have secured **at least 60%** marks in the concerned subjects at the Higher Secondary level.
5. Candidates must have obtained minimum 50% marks in the Higher Secondary level for **offering Core** in other subjects.
6. Candidates **qualifying for Core subjects are only eligible for admission into the Degree Course.**
7. Changes in core subjects can be done within 10 days from the beginning of classes.



REGULATIONS

- ❑ **RAGGING is PROHIBITED within the College premises.** Any student found to be involved in any form of ragging will be expelled from the College. The Anti-Ragging Committee of the College is empowered to take action as and when necessary.
- ❑ It is the obligatory duty of the students to keep the campus and the classrooms clean. They will be liable for punishment for causing any damage or disfiguring of college property.
- ❑ The College gate remains closed till 2 pm. The students are not allowed to leave the campus before 2pm under any circumstances.
- ❑ Students are expected to maintain decency at all times. They should not loiter outside the campus during College hours. Instead they should utilise their off-periods playing games in the Common Room or reading books in the library. They may also contact faculty members for academic consultations.
- ❑ Students must carry their Identity Cards at all times, within the campus.
- ❑ Students failing to attend the classes owing to illness have to submit to the Vice-Principal an application along with **a medical certificate** from a registered physician. For any other absence students shall have to submit application from parents/guardians.
- ❑ An attendance of 80% is compulsory for appearing in examinations. Students attaining less than 80% but above 70% will be deemed as Institutional Private candidates.
- ❑ Wearing of **College Uniform** is compulsory during College hours. **Students wearing improper uniform will be penalized.** However for newcomers a relaxation of 7 days is given.
- ❑ It is compulsory for students to appear in the Unit Tests/ Sessional Examinations/Group Discussions/ Class Seminars etc. conducted internally by the respective Departments.
- ❑ Students have to participate in extension activities, field studies, and social services organised by the college from time to time.
- ❑ Use of **Cell Phones** by students in classrooms is **strictly prohibited.** Violation will invite disciplinary action as well as payment of a fine of Rs. 1000/-. Repeated violation may lead to expulsion from the College. However it may be used in girls' common room when necessary.
- ❑ The caution money for laboratory will be refunded provided the students apply for the same within one month of the declaration of the final semester results.





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AMENITIES

LIBRARY



The user-friendly College Library, equipped with the latest technology and fitted with CCTV cameras has a comprehensive collection of over 25,000 books on a wide range of subjects, encyclopaedia volumes, current journals and magazines and newspapers of national importance. The open stack system, reference section, book bank, spacious reading room, are all intended to create a lively and enriching environment for students. Books can be borrowed twice a week as per the schedule notified in the Library notice-board. It is open to users, six days a week from 9 am to 4 pm on week days and from 9am to 1.30 pm on Saturdays. Digital Library facility has been introduced in the college from the year 2016. Every Department of the college have their own library to facilitate the students. Study materials are provided by the Department as and when necessary to the students.

COMPUTER LAB

With the introduction of Computer Application as a compulsory subject in the BA/BSc Semester Programme of Dibrugarh University, the College has established three well furnished Computer Labs equipped with latest software and operating systems.



ICT :

Information Communication Technology (ICT) system plays an important role in present day's higher education system. Information Technology Department of the Govt. of Assam in association with the Higher Education Department of Assam has implemented an ICT project in our college from 2016.



PGDCA Course :

The college has introduced a self-financing PGDCA course under Dibrugarh University for graduate girls students. Students passing out from this college and from other colleges are eligible for admission.

HOSTEL:

The Devi Nivas Hostel provides comfortable and safe lodgings to a limited number of outstation students. Boarders will be under the supervision of the Hostel Warden and Matrons who reside in the hostel and are accessible at all times. Hygienic food, pure drinking water and uninterrupted power supply, internet connection are some of the important amenities available in the hostel.

HOSTEL ADMISSION AND REGULATION

- Only students from outside Jorhat may apply for hostel admission in the separate forms attached with the prospectus.
- Hostel seats are allotted purely on merit.
- The Hostel admission list will be displayed after college admissions are completed.
- Selected students should report to the Warden along with admission receipts.
- Old boarders must take Hostel admission on the same day of admission into semester classes, failing which their seats may stand forfeited.
- Mess dues are to be paid for the whole year except during semester break.
- There is no provision for half mess dues.
- Boarders are allowed to leave the hostel only after submitting applications duly signed by their Parents/Guardians to the college authority.
- Admission to College does not guarantee accommodation in the hostel as seats are very limited in the first year.

CAREER COUNSELLING & PLACEMENT CELL :

The Career Counselling and Placement Cell of the College has been established with a view to assist students to discover their aptitudes and talents, to make the right subject choices in college, and career choices in the future. A team of dedicated teacher-counsellors are available for academic counselling as well as for consultation and advice on personal and social issues. The Cell organises both pre and post admission orientations, career fairs, skill enhancement and personality development workshops, coaching classes for competitive examinations. Presentations by professional career counsellors and HRD personnel from the corporate sector are periodically organised. The Placement Cell attracts a number of companies every year from various sectors of the corporate world for in-campus placement. Besides, students are groomed for interviews and group discussions.



GENERATOR AND SOLAR POWER :

Generator and solar power facilities are arranged by the college so that uninterrupted power supply may be facilitated to the students.

AUDITORIUM :

An aesthetically designed modern auditorium hosts cultural and major academic programmes of the College.

DIGITAL CLASS ROOM & CONFERENCE HALL :

The students are provided with smart room facilities to acquaint them with the modern teaching tools.



HEALTH CARE :

First aid is provided immediately to the needy students. Sick students are admitted to the near-by hospital or medical college for speedy recovery, if required.



LANGUAGE LAB & VIRTUAL CLASSROOM :

A language laboratory has been set-up in the college for enhancing language skills of the students. Moreover installation of a virtual classroom is also under process.

YOGA & MEDITATION :

The Yoga and Meditation programme of the College under the supervision of a trained instructor aims at developing the learners mentally and physically so that they may overcome the rising level of stress among them and perform well academically.

CANTEEN :

An airy, spacious canteen provides the right ambience for students and the staff to interact over a cup of tea or coffee. Hygienically cooked Vegetarian and Non-Vegetarian food are available at reasonable prices.

VALUE EDUCATION :

The College believes that inculcating the right values to the students would enable them to confront the rigours and stress of the modern complex world. Symposiums on values and art of living are organised on a regular basis.

GRIEVANCE CELL :

For the purpose of grievance redressal, the grievance cell, attached to the IQAC, takes into account the grievances of the students.

REMEDIAL TEACHING :

Students with learning difficulties and who are slow learner are supplemented with remedial teaching by the faculty besides the normal College routine.





PARENT-TEACHER MEET :

As extended members of the college family, we value the presence and support of our esteemed parents. Parent-Teacher Meets are held at regular intervals to develop communication channels which will enable parents and teachers to make plans, set goals, provide feedbacks, solve problems, and establish the relationship for a healthy teaching-learning process in the campus.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION COMMITTEE :

The college has a Disciplinary Action Committee which deals with the maintenance of discipline in the college campus. There are also an **Anti-Ragging Cell** and a **Cell against Sexual Harrassment** in the college for providing assistance to the students in distress.

STUDENTS' UNION :

The DCB Girls' College Students' Union comprising of elected members and nominated class representatives is the ideal training ground for grooming future leadership and team work. It coordinates between the college and the students and conducts all co-curricular activities under the guidance of teachers. All the students of the College are general members of the body.

STUDENTS' AID FUND:

There is a Students' Aid Fund for economically disadvantaged but meritorious students in the college. Students securing 45% and above in their last qualifying examination are eligible for financial assistance from the fund. They have to apply in plain paper to the Principal seeking financial assistance along with an endorsement either from Village Chiefs / President G. P/Ward Members / Teachers of the College.



IQAC:

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college was set up as a part of post-accreditation quality sustenance activities recommended by NAAC in order to enhance quality in a continuous process for academic and administrative excellence.

K.K. HANDIQUE STATE OPEN UNIVERSITY :

K.K. Handique State Open University Centre was opened in the college in the year 2015. At present it offers academic programmes in **Education, Political Science, Assamese**. It provides an ambient academic environment to the students pursuing P.G. Programme in the above subjects

D.EL.ED :

From 2018 the college has started D.EL.ED study centre under NIOS. For eligibility, the candidate must be in teaching profession and must have secured 50% in Higher Secondary Examination. The admission process is carried out by NIOS.

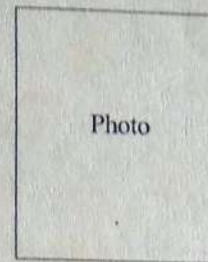
